Course of Study

Introduction

Six Sigma focuses on measuring and quantifying the impact of an improvement project. It requires buy-in across the business for the project to make changes based upon those measurements irrespective of personal views. Guesswork and assumptions have no place, it is a precise process. The Six Sigma Champion is the individual in your company who translates the mission, vision, and values into a Six Sigma deployment strategy which supports the goals of the company. They do this by determining which projects to deploy and identifying resource needs and removal of roadblocks.

The goal of the Management and Strategy Institute is to teach you the key competencies required to function in the role of a Six Sigma Champion. As you go through the training material you will learn the competencies listed below.

The SSCC exam is a timed, online exam. It has a required passing score of 70%.

Team Formation

- Discuss forming a team
 - o <u>Learning Outcome</u>: Have an understanding of how a Six Sigma team is formed.

Team Focus

- Focus of a team
 - <u>Learning Outcome</u>: Understand what each member of a Six Sigma team should be focused on.

Supporting Resources

- What resources are required for a project.
 - <u>Learning Outcome</u>: Understand how to determine what resources will be required for the Six Sigma project being implemented.

Champion Traits

- What to look for in a Champion
 - <u>Learning Outcome</u>: Understand who should take the role of the Six Sigma Champion and what traits they should have.

Pace Mediation

- Controlling the pace of the project.
 - <u>Learning Outcome</u>: Controlling the pace of the project is a critical component of its success. Understand how to control the pace of the project to ensure success.

Roadblocks

- Removal of roadblocks.
 - <u>Learning Outcome</u>: Understand why roadblocks happen during a project and how to remove them.
